AGRIBIZ VILLAGE HUBS

- Our AgriBiz Village Hubs provide platform where young people, women, men and people with disabilities can be given an opportunity to be trained as agripreneurs and work with our partnerfarms. This allows them to be mentored, coached and trained in the business of agriculture. We have realised that our education system does not equip people for a life after school or classroom. During these 12 weeks, we ensure that our candidates are fully equipped in all areas of Agriculture.
- We are committed to provide candidates with training in basic farming, business, finance and leadership skills. By the end of our Agripreneur programme, Candidates will be given an opportunity to decide whether they want to join our team and serve in other different roles and capacities within the company or set up their business.
